- A. Superintendent Report. Superintendent Godino – In 2019, the financial policies were created for the Town of Avon. Through that process a Capital Improvement Committee was created. The schools submitted all capital improvement projects to the committee. The projects were then rated and were to be put forward by the committee for the warrant. Unfortunately, the committee did not stay in place and the process hasn't been forward. Because the masonry project was placed on the warrant I wanted to ensure it was voted on by the committee. The warrant is for \$70,000 for the front stairs of AMHS. They are in need of repair – taped off this week.
