<u>AMHS</u> - School Improvement Plan: Curriculum, RTI is up and running, secure schools/safety – all staff trained, drill in the spring; Advisory curriculum – positive feedback from students/faculty. Communication improvements have been made. Student Counsel is working with DOE – data retrieval. Professional Development: trauma sensitive; suicide prevention – social/emotional impact. The loss of Isiah in the fall has caused the student body to deal with emotions. The students have done many things to honor him – basketball game shirt present and a back to school block party. Lori Sass retired, Jeanne Cartwright moved out of the main office to take that spot. Red Ribbon week, Middle School Pumpkin Run, Drama play about being a teenager, Project 351 – pass the torch – Maeve Hagberg. Gillette for the third year in a row for the MIAA Sportsmanship award. Aces – great American smoke out. Winners of the Spirit Week challenge were the 12th graders. Very busy, a lot of good things happening.

- **BUTLER** School Improvement Plan: Curriculum Katie Frias. Butler had a 2 day training for the new science program during professional development. RTI process – the focus is to make it more simple/streamlined giving every grade level measures social/emotional behavior. Culture – Tier I. Safe schools – staff is trained and drills are planned for the spring. Spike Zone – sensory kits and special boards in place. Transition program for the 6th graders is working well – HS mentors spend time every 2 mos. CARES – more excitement through monthly assembly. School Council has instituted a "value of the month". Bullying is a concern – working on monthly lessons to bring awareness. Community culture – more parent/family involvement. Booster-thon raised \$25K and had 65% participation this year. Diversity – book club to explore the topic. "Winter Olympics" - Student Council – 1000 can drive.
- B. Norfolk County Sheriff's Task Force report: Member Sheehan was impressed by the presentation of material on discipline, rehab, lack of funding at the state level. She will attend the next meeting and will share the date once set up.
- c. Report from the MASS/MASC Conference: Member Sheehan discussion around the MTEL testing – how valid is it, drop it, what will it be replaced with? Banning of styrofoam in schools. Member Hagberg – "Being average is not good enough" was a saying she felt was important; "diversity – refraining to include everyone" was empowering phrase. There was a panel from the Dedham schools that was very powerful and effective.
