 - A. Superintendent's report: Information regarding the coronavirus can be found on the website. All precautions are in place and the risk is still very low. The Tier Focus Monitoring Review will be taking place on March 4 to review SPED data and Civil Rights. Butler Parking Lot: in the process of arranging a meeting with Mike Carter to hopefully finalize plans. All summer programs will be moved to AMHS to allow the start of the Parking Lot Project.
 - B. Projected enrollment: by the NESDC over the next 10 years will increase Avon's student population by 125 students in grade k-8. This will call for renovations at the Butler and will require a look at CHOICE numbers.
 - **C.** Budget: Tracy Sheehan, Paul Chapman, Kathleen McDonald and Superintendent met with the Board of Selectmen and the Finance Committee on Saturday, 2/29. The Budget Subcommittee will meet prior to the regular school committee meeting to discuss the necessary \$200K cut to the budget.
 - D. Student Opportunity Act: Plan must be completed by April 1 and submitted to the state; two proposed positions in the plan. An ELL teacher as we have a high number and testing needs to be done yearly. School adjustment counselor is also a necessity especially in the Middle High School.
 - **E.** Music Program: Mr. Ellis is working to make a bridge with the Butler Elementary School students. He is hoping to start a "musical petting zoo" where the students can check out the available instruments, feel them, ask

questions. The goal is to pair the elementary student with a high school student to mentor the elementary students.
